

# Syllabus update

## Cambridge International AS Level French Literature 8670 (for examination in 2016)

We have updated this syllabus. The latest syllabus is version 3, published September 2015.

Changes have been made to section 6.5, Set texts for 2016:

All the set texts from 2016 will be set again in 2017, not only the first three as previously indicated. Asterisks have been added to all texts to signal this:

Changes made in version 2 of the syllabus for 2016 were as follows:

### Page 29 Section 9.2.1 Timing

The dates for Speaking tests for the November series have been amended. Paragraph 9.2.1 now states:

The Speaking tests take place before the main examination period as follows:

- between 1 October and 24 October for the November examination.

### Page 30, Section 9.2.2 Appointment of examiners, (c) All Centres

The third sentence has been amended to read:

Forms must be sent to Cambridge at least four weeks before the start of the Speaking test period.
