



Cambridge Handbook supplement (March 2025 series)

This supplement outlines where regulations and guidance for administering Cambridge exams are different for the March series. Alongside this guide, exams officers must also read and understand the Cambridge Handbook, available at www.cambridgeinternational.org/examsofficersguide

Phase 1 – Preparation

Preparing your exams timetable

In April, we publish a provisional version of the timetable for the following March series on Direct. At this point you can let us know if you have any major concerns.

Email any comments to info@cambridgeinternational.org with 'March series provisional timetable' and your centre number in the subject line. You have four weeks from the date this is published to give any feedback.

Once we have considered any comments we publish the final version of the timetable in June. After the final timetable has been published, we cannot accept any requests to change exam dates.

The Key Times for schools in **India** are:

- **Morning session:** 10:30 India Standard Time (05:00 Greenwich Mean Time/Coordinated Universal Time)
- **Afternoon session:** 14:30 India Standard Time (09:00 Greenwich Mean Time/Coordinated Universal Time).

The Key Times for schools in **Romania** are:

- **Morning session:** 07:00 Eastern European Standard Time (05:00 Greenwich Mean Time/Coordinated Universal Time)
- **Afternoon session:** 11:00 Eastern European Standard Time (09:00 Greenwich Mean Time/Coordinated Universal Time).

Phase 2 – Entries

Making final entries

Important dates

You can make entries for the March 2025 series from
13 September 2024.

Final entries deadline for first-time entries:
27 November 2024

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Late entries deadline for first-time entries:
14 December 2024

Final deadline for retake entries from the November 2024 series only: 22 January 2025

We charge a late entry fee for any first-time entries or changes we receive between 28 November and 14 December 2024.

Retake entries

You can submit retake entries for candidates entered in the November 2024 series until 22 January 2025 without being charged late entry fees as long as:

- the candidate sat the same syllabus, regardless of the option code, in the November 2024 exam series
- you submit the candidate's previous centre number and candidate number correctly
- you indicate that the syllabus entry is a retake entry when you first submit it to us by ticking the 'retake' box next to the entry.

Statements of entry

Download statements of entry from the 'Reports' tab on **Direct** (you do not receive printed statements in your exam despatch).

Cambridge International AS & A Level staged assessment

Candidates can use their March series Cambridge International AS Level results towards a Cambridge International A Level (of the same subject) in a later exam series, except for the June series of the same year. Cambridge International AS Level results can be carried forward twice within 13 months of the series when the candidate took the AS Level.

You must use our **Carry-forward Regulations Supplement** to help you understand the entry you should make if you have candidates who wish to carry forward marks.

For example:

Candidates can use their Cambridge International AS Level results achieved in the March 2024 series towards the award of a Cambridge International A Level in the November 2024 and/or the March 2025 series, but not the June 2024 series.

Carrying forward internally assessed marks

Candidates wishing to take a syllabus again in a future exam series may want to retake the written components and carry forward the moderated marks they achieved in their internally assessed components. Individual syllabuses specify whether candidates can do this or not. If the syllabus allows it you can carry forward Cambridge IGCSE™

marks once and Cambridge International AS Level marks twice within a 13-month period. Marks for the March 2024 series cannot be carried forward to the June 2025 series.

For example:

Candidates can carry forward their internally assessed component marks achieved in the March 2024 series to complete a Cambridge International AS Level in the November 2024 series. This AS Level cannot itself be carried forward towards a Cambridge International A Level in the March 2025 series.

Alternative venues

Apply for alternative venues at least four weeks before the exam.

Deadline for submitting internally assessed marks:
27 February 2025

Submitting coursework and speaking test samples

Important dates

We need to receive your samples by 27 February 2025.

Phase 4 – Before the exams

Forecast grades

You must submit forecast grades to us by 27 February 2025.

Pre-exam and question paper despatches

Important dates

We send despatches to you on the dates in the table below. The dates below are for entries made by the first-time entries deadline. Despatches for retake or late entries will arrive later.

Early question papers for speaking tests	Mid-December 2024
Confidential instructions for practical exams	Mid-December 2024
Question papers	Mid-January 2025
Pre-exam despatch	Late January 2025

*For all entries made by the first-time entries deadline only (27 November 2024), pre-exam despatch ('admin') materials will be packed and sent with question paper packets in the main question paper despatch. 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Art & Design syllabuses

For Cambridge IGCSE Art & Design (0400/02) and Cambridge International AS & A Level Art & Design (9479/02), question papers will be available on the School Support Hub from 1 November 2024. Question papers will only be available on Digital File Despatch if you have made final entries.

You are responsible for preparing candidates for their exam using the question papers for the correct exam series.

We will send your certificates by late June 2025. Email info@cambridgeinternational.org if you do not receive them by the end of June 2025. We charge for replacement certificates after 16 June 2025. We also charge a courier fee. The fees are in our fees list, which is available from the 'My Messages' section of Direct. We can only replace March 2025 certificates until 31 January 2027. After this date you will need to apply for a certifying statement.

Certifying statements, verification of results and priority results applications

Important dates

To apply for priority results, the candidate or the centre where the candidate took the exam(s) must complete and return Results and Certificates – Form 9 by 30 April 2025.
