	Changes to syllabus	<p>Set text rotations</p> <p>A statement has been added on page 7 about the rotation of set texts. Set texts regularly rotate on the syllabus and may change from one year of examination to the next. Before you begin teaching, check the set text list for the year in which your candidates will take their examinations.</p> <p>Previous changes to version 2, published June 2018.</p> <p>Set text editions</p> <p>This update is to further clarify that editions of set texts which include annotations, highlighting or notes cannot be taken into open-book examinations. Clean copies of texts should be used in the exam.</p> <p>Updates to the syllabus have been made to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Page 14 – information about editions of set texts suitable for classroom study. • Page 16 – information about the use of clean copy set texts in the assessment for Paper 3 Drama (Open text).
