

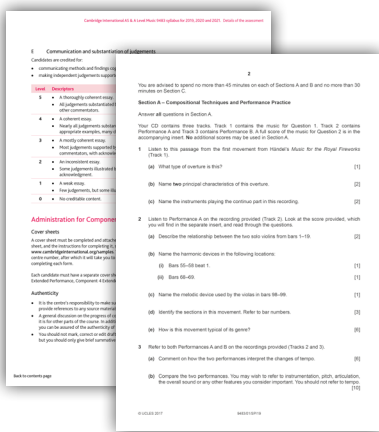

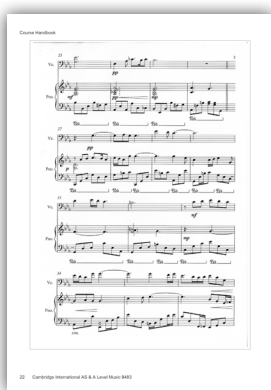


Syllabus and assessment materials

The syllabus is well designed, interesting to teach, accessible to learners and has been updated for first teaching in 2018. It explains what your learners need to know, how they will be assessed, and the relationship between assessment objectives and the examination papers.

Use the specimen papers and mark schemes to familiarise yourself with the overall assessment approach.

Changes to content or assessment are listed in this syllabus. You will need to be aware of these when using past papers and mark schemes from earlier series.



Course Handbook

The Course Handbook offers guidance on organising and planning your teaching and how to prepare your learners for the assessed elements of the syllabus. It also offers advice on the requirements of Cambridge International A Level Music 9483 and provides examples of candidate work which demonstrate how the assessment criteria are applied.

There are example video and audio recordings of candidates to help to demonstrate the various Components at AS Level. These are accessible via a link in the Course Handbook and provide an opportunity for you to practise your marking by assessing the candidates yourself and comparing your marks to those of the examiner comments in the handbook.
