Each Cambridge Pre-U examination must be taken on the day shown in this timetable and at the time shown above.

Centres in the UK can start examinations up to thirty minutes earlier than, or later than, the published starting time for the session. To maintain the security of the examinations, all candidates must start morning Cambridge Pre-U examinations between 08.30 am and 09.30 am. Afternoon Cambridge Pre-U examinations must start between 1.00 pm and 2.00 pm.
