We work with schools worldwide to build an education that shapes knowledge, understanding and skills.

- We are the world's largest provider of international education programmes and qualifications for 3 to 19 year olds.
- Over **10 000** schools in more than **160** countries offer Cambridge programmes and qualifications.
- We work with governments and partners in **75** countries.
- With more than 160 years' experience in international education, Cambridge now serves nearly **two million** students annually.
- We are part of Cambridge University Press & Assessment, a not-for-profit organisation and part of the world-renowned University of Cambridge.

### Programmes and qualifications

- The Cambridge Pathway has **five stages**, starting with Cambridge Early Years which was introduced globally in 2023.
- Cambridge Primary is offered by more than **3 400** schools in **133** countries. There are over **165 000** entries for Cambridge Primary Checkpoint tests each year.
- Cambridge Lower Secondary is offered by more than **2 300** schools in **103** countries. Every year we receive over **160 000** entries for Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoint tests.
- We developed the International GCSE (IGCSE) qualification which was first examined in 1988. Cambridge IGCSE is the world's most popular international curriculum for 14 to 16 year olds: it is offered by over **7 000** schools in **147** countries and is available in over **70** subjects.
- We are the world's biggest provider of O Level qualifications. Cambridge O Level is offered by more than **3 000** schools in **54** countries and is available in over **40** subjects.
- Cambridge International AS & A Levels are offered by almost **5 000** schools in **138** countries. Schools can choose from more than **55** subjects.



- Over **2 670** universities in **99** countries formally recognise Cambridge qualifications, including all UK universities and over **1 070** in the US.

### Delivering exams worldwide

- Cambridge began examining internationally in **1864**. The first Cambridge international exams were taken in Trinidad by six candidates.
- In 2025, Cambridge International Education awarded results to over **one million** learners globally – more than in any previous year.
- We produce over **10 million** question papers each year.

### Support for schools

- Our published teaching and learning resources are trusted by more than **1.5 million** teachers and learners worldwide.
- Teachers can access over **40 000** high-quality teaching and learning resources on our School Support Hub.
- Every year we run almost **2 000** online, virtual and face-to-face professional development courses, reaching around **30 000** education professionals.
- Over **260** institutions around the world offer Cambridge Professional Development Qualifications for teachers and school leaders.
