I am writing to officially advise that Monash University Australia globally recognises and accepts the General Certificate of Education (GCE) A Levels awarded by Cambridge International, including predicted results issued by registered Cambridge International schools, for admission into all of our undergraduate courses and pathway programs.

Monash University will also accept GCE A Level grades issued by Cambridge International for the May/June 2020 series for assessment and consideration in the same manner as those from other series.

With regards to gaining entry based upon Cambridge International GCE A Level predictive results, Monash University Australia acknowledges the importance of providing full admission into our courses based on these results given our Australian semester commencement dates (Semester 1, February to June and Semester 2, July to November).

Registered Cambridge International schools are monitored by Monash University to ensure that the Cambridge International GCE A Level predicted results are a true reflection of the student's final result. Cambridge International registered schools that provide inaccurate predictions to Monash University are subject to possible removal from the list of Monash University approved schools.

Further details of the Cambridge International GCE A Level entry requirements and predicted results process applicable to international students are attached to this letter. This information is valid until further notice from Monash University.

Monash University 2021 International Undergraduate Entry Requirements

(applicable to international students only)

Students must satisfy all of the following requirements for entry into a Monash University undergraduate course:

- minimum age requirements
- academic entry requirements (from an <u>approved qualification</u> such as Cambridge International GCE A Levels)
- English entry requirements
- prerequisite subjects and additional requirements (if applicable).

Cambridge International GCE A Level academic entry requirements and approved subjects to meet English and prerequisite subject requirements are located in the <u>2021 international undergraduate</u> <u>course guide</u>.

Predicted Results:

Monash accepts GCE A Level predicted results issued by registered Cambridge International schools* for entry into all undergraduate courses for 2021 intake as follows (other guidelines may apply):

- The score (calculated by Monash) of the Cambridge International GCE A Level predicted results must be 1 point higher than the Monash course's academic entry requirement.
- Predicted results in approved Cambridge International subjects are accepted as meeting English and prerequisite subject requirements. Refer to pages 84 and 85 of the <u>2021</u> international undergraduate course guide.
- All other Monash course requirements must also be satisfied.

The predicted result submitted must:

- state the full name of the qualification the student will obtain on completion of the program, and
- specify the predicted grades for the Cambridge International GCE A Level subjects the student is currently completing, and
- be issued on institution letterhead, signed by the principal, teacher, school counsellor, registrar
 of the institution, or their authorised delegate no more than 2 years prior to the first day of
 Monash University orientation week

If students have a combination of final and predicted Cambridge International GCE A Level results the above process also applies.

*Some schools are not accepted however students are encouraged to provide their predicted results (along with their centre number and candidate number) to Monash for assessment.

Cambridge International GCE A Level documents accepted by Monash:

Monash accepts <u>Cambridge International GCE A Level</u> final results OR statement of results where students are also required to provide their centre number and candidate number for assessment. Online results can also be considered however Monash may request students to provide original or certified documents upon request.

How to apply to Monash:

International students must apply directly to Monash University online.

The following students cannot apply directly to Monash University, therefore visit How to Apply:

- Australian citizens*
- New Zealand citizens*
- Australian permanent residents
- Holders of an Australian permanent humanitarian visa
