### Additional guidance for Component 9787/01: Verse Literature

#### Prescribed texts

Translation and literary analysis questions will be set from the following lines only:

**Euripides, *Alcestis* 1–27, 136–212, 280–342, 509–567, 803–860, 1008–1024, 1037–1158**

For the essay questions, candidates should be familiar with the rest of the play in translation.

or

**Homer, *Iliad* 6. 1–155, 206–285, 313–502**

For the essay questions, candidates should be familiar with the rest of *Iliad* 6 in translation.

The **paired texts** remain unchanged.

### Additional guidance for Component 9787/02: Prose Literature

#### Prescribed texts

Translation and literary analysis questions will be set from the following sections only:

**Thucydides, Book 4. 11–16, 19–23, 27–32, 36–41**

For the essay questions, candidates should also be familiar with sections 1–10, 17–18, 26 and 33–35 in translation.

or

**Lysias XII, *Against Eratosthenes* 4–23, 43–61, 79–100**

For the essay questions candidates should also be familiar with the rest of *Lysias XII* in translation.
