Additional guidance for Component 9788/01: Verse Literature

Prescribed texts

Translation and literary analysis questions will be set from the following lines only:

Virgil, *Aeneid* 7. 148–562

For the essay questions, candidates should also be familiar with *Aeneid* 7. 563–640 in translation.

or

Juvenal, *Satire* 1 and *Satire* 3. 1–163, 190–222, 268–301, 315–22

For the essay questions, candidates should also be familiar with the rest of *Satire* 3 in translation.

The **paired texts** remain unchanged.

Additional guidance for Component 9788/02: Prose Literature

Prescribed texts

Translation and literary analysis questions (Questions 1–6, 7 and 10) will be set from the following sections only:

Tacitus, *Annals* 14. 1–13, 51–65

For the essay questions, candidates should also be familiar with sections 14–16 and 47–50 in translation.

or

Apuleius, *Metamorphoses* 6. 1–24
