

Cambridge IGCSE (9-1) candidate grades November 2022

Cumulative world totals grades 9 - 1

These figures may differ from those of previous November series. Mainly this is because of substantial differences in the profile of candidates entered. The awarding standard in November 2022 was set at a midpoint between the exam standard of 2019 and the school-assessed grades standard of 2021.

We offer two different grade sets to report candidates' performance in a number of Cambridge IGCSE syllabuses for schools in administrative zone 3, and in UAE and Oman.

The 9-1 syllabuses and corresponding examinations included in this document are identical to their equivalent A*-G graded syllabuses.
