What is the Cambridge results despatch?

Your results despatch contains the printed information and documents you need for your provisional exam results. Your Cambridge Guide to Results Despatch lists the documents included in your results despatch, and what to do with them.

What documents are included in the despatch?

Document	Description
Statements of results for candidates	Each statement lists all the syllabuses entered by an individual candidate and the syllabus grades awarded
Results broadsheet for teaching staff	A summary of all the results for your candidates. This broadsheet shows the results in a grid with the names of all candidates listed down the left-hand side and syllabus titles listed across the top
Results by syllabus, option, and component for teaching staff	A list of all your results and component grades by syllabus, option and component. We give component grades in confidence to teaching staff and they should not generally be made public
Moderation adjustment summary reports for teaching staff (where applicable)	A summary of moderation adjustments for every internally assessed component
