## **Quick reference overview**

- Step 1 Log in to the **Digital Mocks Service** application.
- Step 2 From the Home page, click on the series you want to view results for.
- Step 3 Click on **Mock exam results**.
- Step 4 Click the mock exam you want to view results for.
- Step 5 You will see a list of all candidates (**Overall results** screen) and their results if available.
- Step 6 Click **Export overall report** to export the overall results in CSV or PDF format.
- Step 7 Click a student's **Candidate number** to view the question-level results.
- Step 8 Click **Export Individual Reports** to export question-level results in CSV or PDF format.

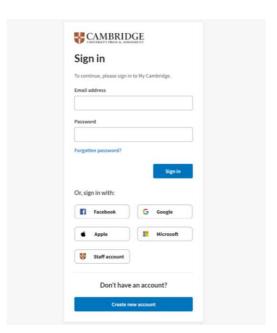
# **Accessing the Digital Mocks Service application**

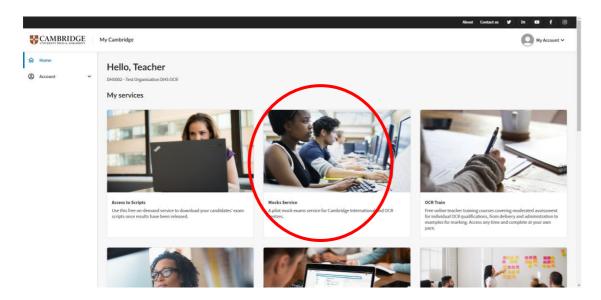
- You can access reports in the Digital Mocks Service application accessed via My Cambridge.
- Access My Cambridge at <a href="https://sso.cambridge.org/login">https://sso.cambridge.org/login</a> and log in to your account using your registered email address and password.

For centres in China, please refer to the appendix <u>here</u> for how to access the Digital Mocks Service application.

- If you are a new My Cambridge user you will have received a separate email from us with details of how to create your account.
- Do not use the 'Create new account' button as it will not be linked to your centre.
- If you have not received an email from us, first check your spam folder and then contact your exams officer.



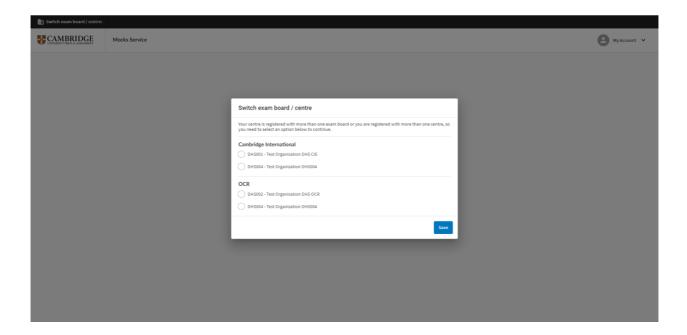
On your My Cambridge Home page select the Mocks Service tile by clicking on it.



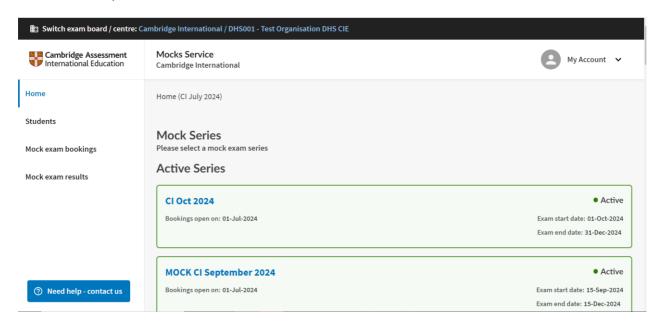
# **Selecting centres**

When you click on the **Mocks Service** tile in **My Cambridge** it will open the **Digital Mocks Service** application.

If your centre is registered with more than one exam board or you are registered with more than one centre, you will need to select which centre and exam board you want to book. Click **Save** to continue and open the Home page.



You can switch to a different exam board or centre from the Home page by selecting the centre name in the top-left corner of the screen.



## Select a series

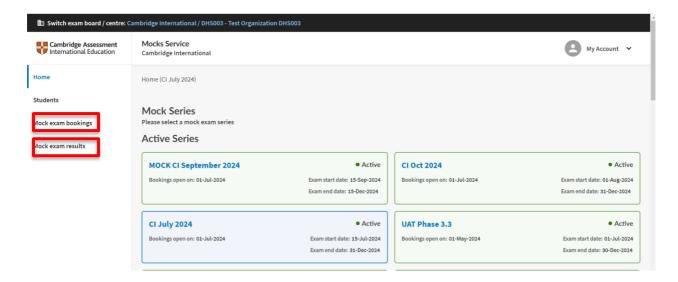
On the Home page you will see the available mock exam series grouped by active and past series. When you select a series it will become blue.

The **Mock exam results** shortcut will be active (no longer greyed out) in the left-hand menu.

To view the results, select **Mock exam results** from the left-hand menu or the **Open mock exam results** next steps button. You will be taken to the **Mock exam results** page.

If results are not available, Mock exam results on the side bar menu will remain greyed out.

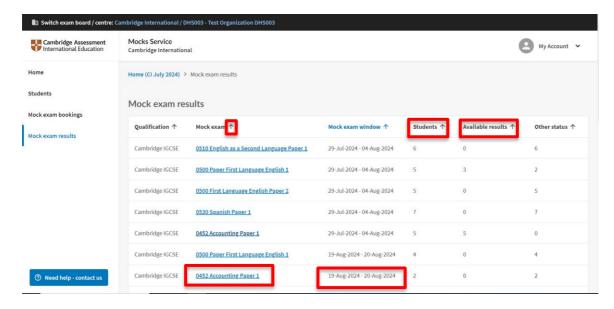
- If Cambridge examiners will mark the exams, we will release results in the Digital Mocks Service application within 14 days from the end of the session (exam window).
- If the exam will be auto-marked, results will usually be available within hours.



On the **Mock exam results** page each row represents a booking for a particular mock exam.

It shows the qualification, the name of the mock exam, the window it was booked in, the number of students in the booking, the number of students with results available and the number with another status.

You can sort any column by clicking on its header (ascending – arrow up, descending – arrow down).

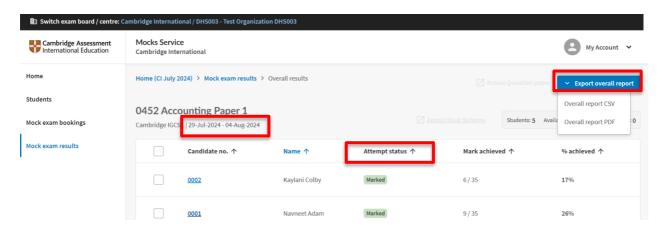


# **Accessing results reports**

#### **Overall results report**

To view the **overall results** for a particular mock exam booking (with results available) click its name in the **Mock exam** column.

You can now view the overall results for all candidates who sat the exam in the particular window. This includes total mark achieved and total percentage mark.



The **Attempt status** of a mock exam can be:

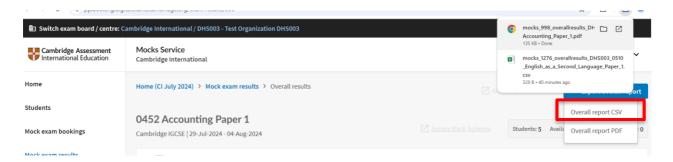
- Pending the mock exam has not yet been completed in RM Assessment Master.
- **Marking** the mock exam has been completed in RM Assessment Master and marking is in progress.
- Marked marking is complete and the results are available to view.

The results can be viewed on screen; alternatively, you can download a CSV or PDF report of the overall results.

- To download the overall results report, click Export overall report.
- Select either CSV or PDF format.

Depending on the settings in your browser, the PDF or CSV files generated will be downloaded to your default download location.

You can then open them in the default applications for these file formats.

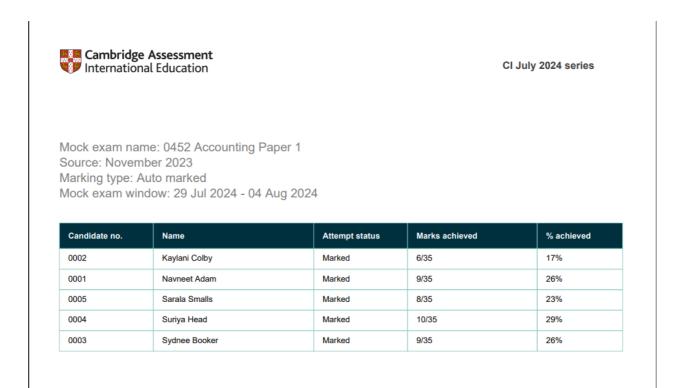


The filename of the PDF or CSV files generated is an amalgamation of the following:

- mocks prefix indicating a mocks results report
- **booking ID** the booking ID the report relates to, allowing you to correlate back to the original booking
- overall results the type of report
- centre number your centre number
- mock exam name the mock exam name.

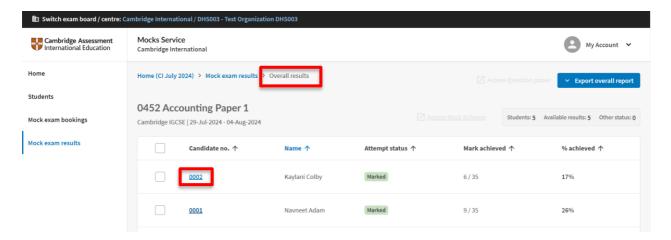
Here is an example of the overall results report for the mock exam booking in PDF format.

The report lists each student with the marks achieved out of marks available and the percentage mark they achieved for the exam.



#### **Question level results report**

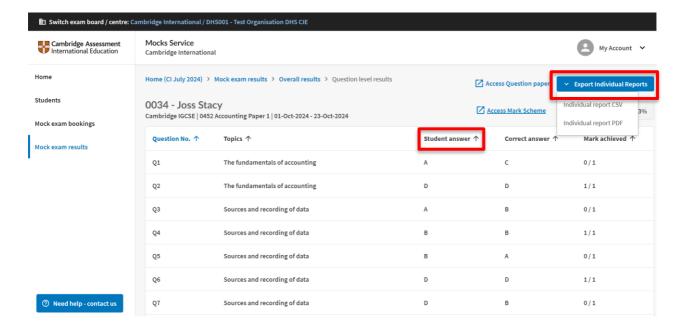
To access the question level results report for each student, click the candidate number on the **Overall results** page.



For the student selected, the **Question level results** screen shows a breakdown of marks for each question in their mock exam. The data shown here may differ depending on the exam type.

In the example below for a multiple-choice test, you will see the question number, the student answer, the correct response and the marks achieved out of marks available.

You can export the question level results in CSV or PDF format. Select the **Export Individual Reports** button in the top-right corner and then choose the CSV or PDF option.



**Note:** The student's response is displayed if it is in plain text or is a multiple-choice question. Responses to other question types cannot be presented on the question level results page.

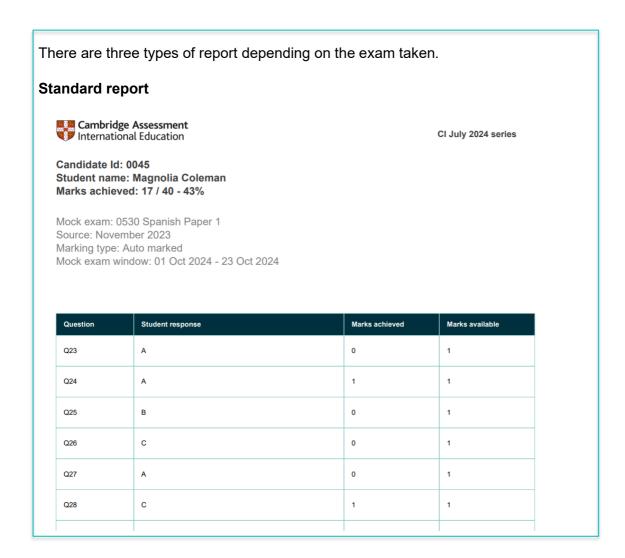
In this case, you will see **Click here to view student response**. Click the link and the student's response will open in a new browser tab in RM Assessment Master.

Once you have viewed the student's response you can close the browser tab.

Where the student's responses cannot be presented on the question level results page they will not show in the PDF or CSV file exports either. Instead, you will see:

# For this question the student response cannot be displayed in the Student response column.

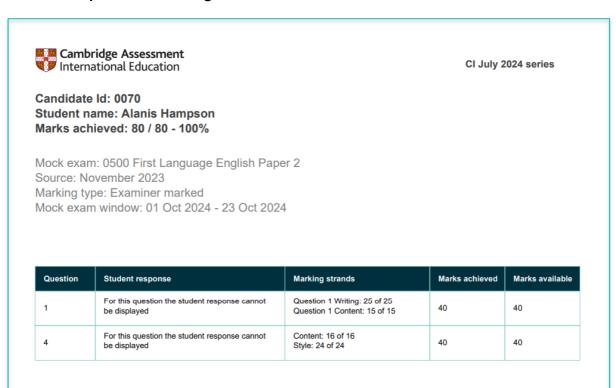
The exported question level results report for each student lists the question number, the response given for each question, the marks achieved and the marks available.

#### Standard report with marking strands

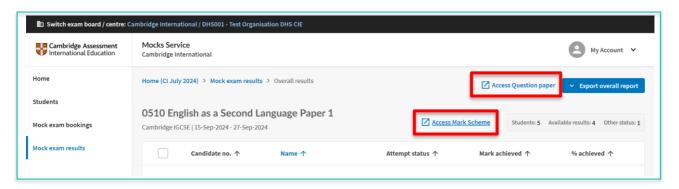


# Accessing the source content question paper and mark scheme

You can view and download the original paper-based question paper and mark scheme from the 'Overall results' or 'Question level results' pages for each mock exam booked.

To do this, click the Access Question paper and Access Mark Scheme links on either page.

The question paper or mark scheme will open in a browser tab and you can download it in PDF format.

- Step 7 Click a student's **Candidate number** to view the question-level results.
- Step 8 Click **Export Individual Reports** to export question-level results in CSV or PDF format
