This term, we are thrilled to feature **Sunbeam World School** in India, in our first *Online School Spotlight*!



The festival featured a diverse range of events tailored to students' interests and abilities. **Poetry enthusiasts** took centre stage in the *Poetry Recital* and *Slam Poetry Competition*, while budding authors crafted imaginative narratives in *Story Dice* and *Create Your Picture Book*.
