



Guide to completing the Application Form

We have designed the application form to enable you to give us some important details about you and your motivations for becoming a trainer. We have deliberately limited the size of some of the boxes and made some answers obligatory. We hope that the application form is easy to complete but we would value your feedback to trainerinfo@cambridgeinternational.org

Please note that the software we are using does not allow you to save a copy of your form. We suggest you take time to review the example questions document, prepare carefully to ensure you have all the information you need before you complete the online form, and make a note of the information you are providing. We estimate that the form will take around 45-60 minutes to complete.

Section 1 – Personal and Contact information - Please type carefully and check. We will use your personal email address to communicate with you, so please ensure this is correct and that your provider will not filter out emails from us.

Section 2 – Teaching and Training Experience – We are selecting trainers who have at least 3 years experience teaching their syllabus and preferably using Cambridge University Press print and digital resources. Please select only the Cambridge syllabus(es) that you have experience of teaching.

It is beneficial if you have had some experience of training fellow teachers, or of adult education approaches.

Section 3 – Examining Experience – Please give details of any examining/ marking work you have carried out, even if it is not for Cambridge.

Section 4 – Employment History- We require trainers to have a current attachment to a Cambridge school. Please give details accordingly.

Section 5 - Key question

This section requires responses of 200-300 words for the following prompt:

- What makes you a strong candidate for the role of a Cambridge trainer?

Please provide specific examples of your skills, experience, and personal attributes that align with this role. Consider including details of your teaching and training background, familiarity with Cambridge curricula, successful training sessions you have led, and any feedback or impact you have made in previous professional development setting.

Please note that your answers to these questions are a very important part of the selection procedure and will be graded.

Please answer **in your own words**, thinking carefully before you respond and using personal examples rather than generic ideas. We do not permit the use of GenAI and if detected your response will be downgraded.

Section 6 - Video questions - As part of the application, you will be required to respond to three key questions in a video format. The process is designed to be clear and structured, with the necessary guidance provided on-screen. Before starting, you will have the opportunity to test your audio and visual equipment to ensure proper recordings.

For each question:

- You will be allocated time to prepare before recording your response.
- The interface will guide you through the steps, ensuring a smooth and straightforward process.
- The entire video response section will take approximately 20 minutes to complete.

Please ensure you are in a quiet and well-lit environment before beginning. This is your opportunity to present your thoughts clearly and confidently, using relevant examples from your experience.

Section 7 – Declaration - Please note that we require you to confirm all the statements in the declaration. If you are unable to do this, then we cannot proceed with your application.

Once you have completed the application form, click submit. We will contact you after the application deadline to let you know whether you will be invited to the next stage of the application process or not.

- Are you currently teaching in a Cambridge school?
- If successful at stage 1 you must be available to attend the Virtual showcases (delivered online) during the week beginning 12 October 2026. If you progress to our final selection phase, would you be able to attend the face-to-face selection scheduled for your country on the **23 & 24 November 2026** in Dhaka, Bangladesh OR **3 & 4 December** in Colombo, Sri Lanka?

Note: NO support with travel and accommodation costs will be available to applicants and we expect applicants to attend the event in their own country.
