**Crush Box:** A project aimed at improving communication among students.

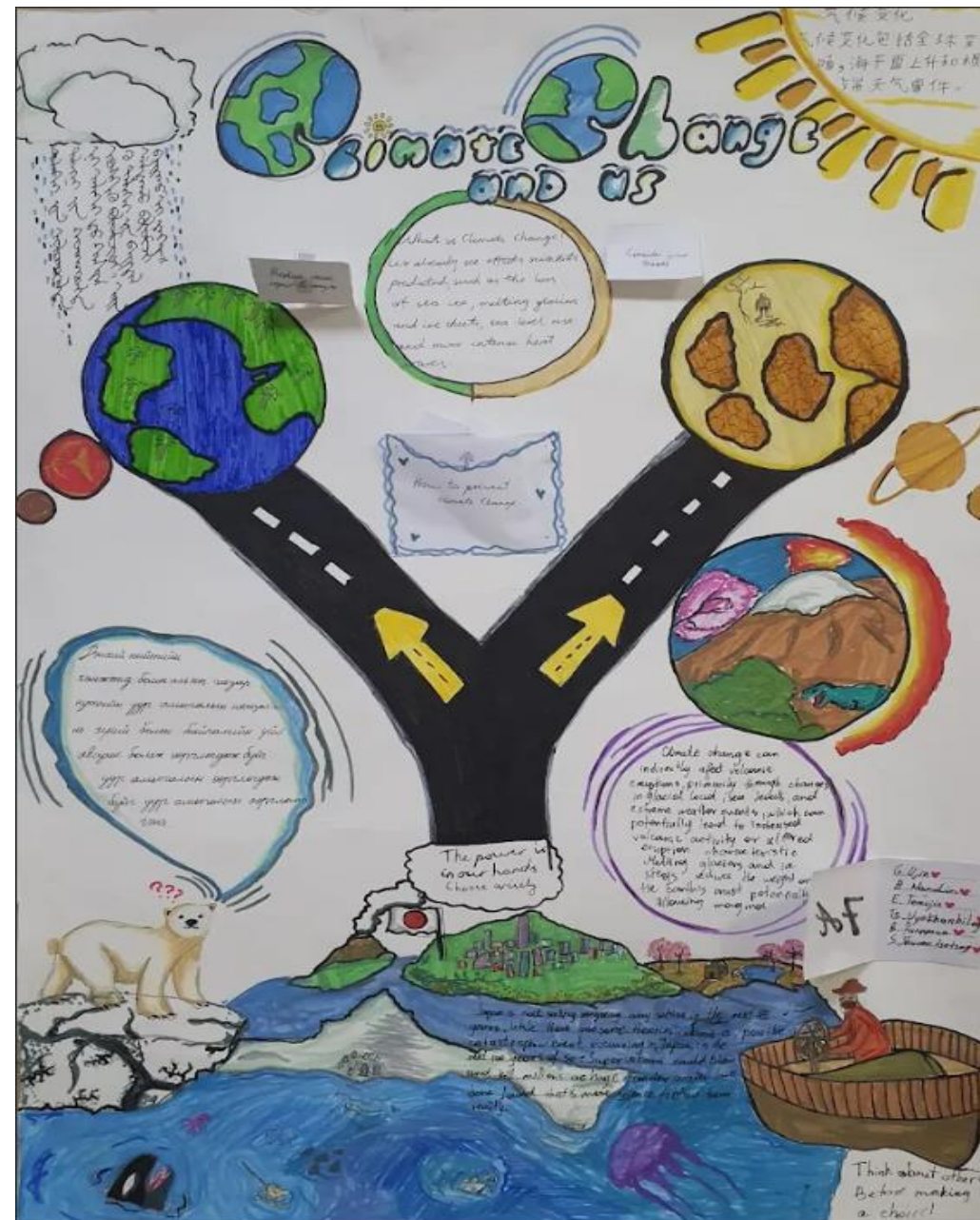
**Emergency Box:** A project providing sanitary products for girls, ensuring access to essentials in times of need.



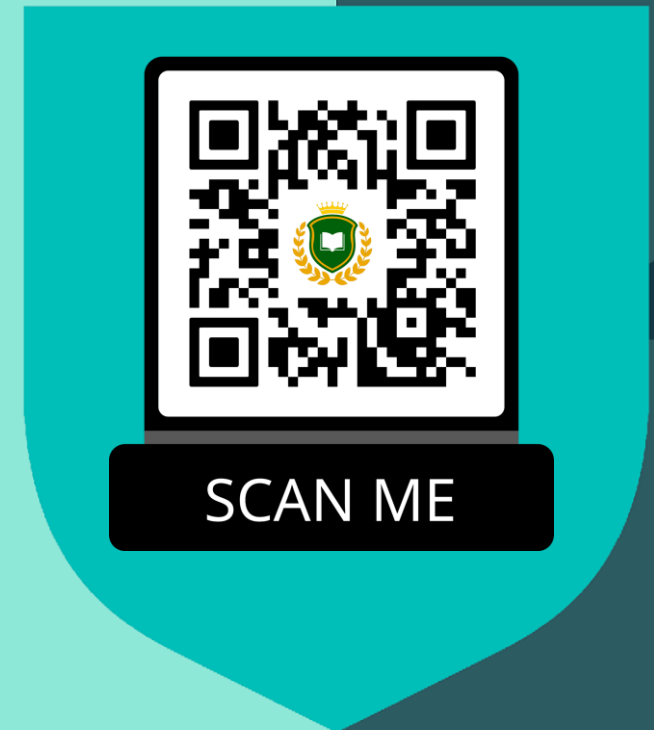
